

I. GOD IS ON A MISSION

- God has a big heart. God cares about all the people of the earth.

Gen 12:3 And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.

- Because of God heart, His love, His mission, He sent Jesus, His Son to save us (Matt. 1:1; John 8:58; Gal. 3:14)

John 3:16-17 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. ¹⁷ For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved.

II. JESUS FULFILLED HIS MISSION

- Jesus' main message and His main mission was to preach the Kingdom of God (Luke 4:43; 8:1; 11:20). God's Kingdom brings joy and peace. The kingdoms of this world are opposed to the Kingdom of God (Rom. 14:17)

- Jesus has completed His mission (John 17:4) and God's Kingdom will cover the entire earth (Matt. 13:31-32).

III. JESUS HAS CALLED YOU TO A MISSION

- Jesus sends us out with a mission (John 20:21). Everyone lives for some reason or purpose.

Matt. 28:18 And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. ¹⁹ GO therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰ teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.

Matt. 10:7-8 And as you go, preach, saying, "The kingdom of heaven is at hand." 8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out demons. Freely you have received, freely give.

- The Gospel started in Jerusalem and with the Jewish people. Israel has temporarily rejected Jesus so that the world will accept Him. After the world has had a chance, all Israel will be saved (Rom. 11:1-2, 25-26).

Acts 1:8 But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.

- The Gospel will be preached to the ends of the earth then Jesus will return. When we finish the work that Jesus commissioned us to, He will return (Matt. 24:14).
